December 1, 2022 **Completing the FASFA (11th & 12th Grade Littles)**: Our presenter will go over the steps you need to take to complete the FASFA. Why complete a FASFA you ask? The FAFSA is the financial aid form for accessing grants, federal student loans and work-study funds at all universities. Filling out the free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA, is one of the most important steps students and their families can take to pay for college. This class is for 12<sup>th</sup> graders and their parents/guardians and Bigs. Littles in 11th grade may join the class but a FASFA is not completed until the start of 12th grade. ##### **JL Bedsole Scholars Program**

The J.L. Bedsole Baccalaureate Scholarship application is now officially online! Candidates for the Bedsole Scholarship must express a desire to use their abilities to further the civic, cultural, and economic development of southwest Alabama. Leadership is the most important criteria. Furthermore, candidates must be planning to pursue a Baccalaureate degree at a qualifying 4-year institution within the State of Alabama the opportunity to receive up to \$6,000 per year. **Treadwell Foundation Scholarship** is an academic scholarship offered to graduating High School Seniors in Mobile County, Alabama who wish to further their education by attending a college or university in Mobile County which includes Bishop State Community College, Coastal Alabama Community College, the University of South Alabama, Spring Hill College and the University of Mobile. Students who are eligible for the scholarship are selected by Mobile County High School Guidance Counselors and one from Big Brothers Big Sisters of South Alabama. Those who are interested in their Little's applying, can contact their Match Specialist to get an application. Applications do not typically come out until January or February. When they do, we will send it out to everyone. We will then set a date it will be due back to us. It will allow us time to determine our selection and provide moc interviews for the Little. We will submit our nominee's application to the Treadwell Foundation by the deadline. The Treadwell Foundation Board meets in April or early May to review the applications, conduct interviews and select the student(s) to receive the scholarship. Required Documents: High School Transcript, ACT or SAT Scores, Completed Application Form Submitted by Big Brothers Big Sisters.
